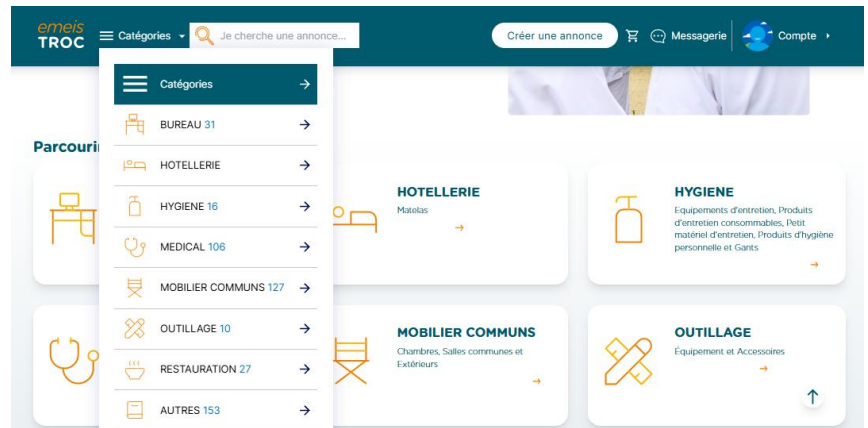
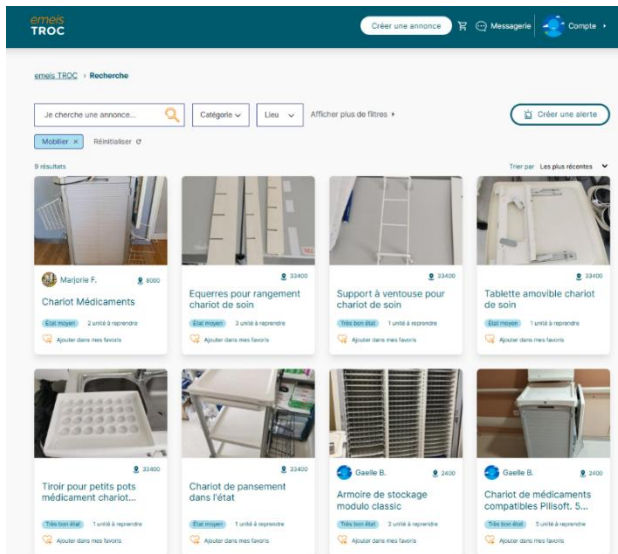
emeis, in partnership with MyTroc Pro, is rolling out “emeis TROC”, an internal digital platform for the reuse of professional equipment. MyTroc Pro, a French start-up specialising in the circular economy, focuses on developing digital reuse platforms for large organisations and public sector bodies. Its solutions help reduce costs, waste and the carbon footprint by facilitating the sharing and circulation of existing resources.

emeis is taking concrete action to protect the environment by offering facilities the opportunity to reduce waste, particularly given that the healthcare sector accounts for nearly 8% of greenhouse gas emissions in France, or approximately 49 million tonnes of CO₂ equivalent per year¹. Accessible to all the group’s facilities and business lines, the platform enables the identification, sharing and reallocation of unused equipment between sites, such as office and hospitality furniture, catering equipment, certain medical devices and technical equipment.

Very easy to use, facilities can post equipment that has become unused locally, view available items, and use the platform to arrange connections and the transfer of equipment between facilities. Since its launch in November 2025, emeis TROC has over 1,300 registered staff members and nearly 500 equipment listings. To date, facilities have exceeded 100 000€ in internal equipment transfers, helping to reduce the need for new equipment.

This initiative forms part of the Group’s CSR strategy and has ambitions that extend beyond the internal scope. Ultimately, emeis aims to expand this initiative and open it up to other stakeholders in the healthcare sector, public, private and voluntary organisations, in order to boost the momentum of re-use and resource sharing.
